

Three Weight Rib & Garter Stitch Beanie



IF using bulky yarn:

You will use size 9(US) DPNs 1st, then use size 10½(US) DPNs 2nd, cast 57 stitches onto your size 9 needles

IF using worsted yarn:

You will use size 7(US) DPNs 1st, then use size 8(US) DPNs 2nd, cast 73 stitches onto your size 7 needles

IF using fingering yarn:

You will use size 6(US) DPNs 1st, then use size 7(US) DPNs 2nd, cast on 93 stitches onto your size 9 needles

Instructions for all sizes:

Joining

Join the round by slipping the first stitch onto your needle, then pass the new second stitch over the slipped stitch. This shall create an invisible join and decrease your stitch count by 1 (57 to 56, 73 to 72, 93 to 92). Demonstration here (not mine!):

Rib Stitch section

K2,P2 repeat * for 2 inches

Garter Stitch section

knit one round, purl one round, repeat for 5 inches

End garter stitch section on a purl round.

Decrease

Round 1: *K9, k2tog* repeat * to end of round.

Round 2: Purl all stitches.

Round 3: *K7, k2tog* repeat * to end of round.

Round 4: Purl all stitches.

Round 5: *K5, k2tog* repeat * to end of round.

Round 6: Purl all stitches.

Round 7: *K4, k2tog* repeat * to end of round.

Round 8: Purl all stitches.

Round 9: *K3, k2tog* repeat * to end of round.

Round 10: Purl all stitches.

Round 11: *K2, k2tog* repeat * to end of round.

Round 12: Purl all stitches.

Round 13: *K1, k2tog* repeat * to end of round.

Finishing

Cut yarn leaving a 10-inch tail, thread onto needle and pull through remaining stitches. Weave in your ends. If you'd like: you can make a pompom and attach, and/or block
